

Program Funding

In compliance with the Stevens Amendment, funding details for program year 2022-2023 are provided as follows (Note: this includes carry forward funding from prior program years, as applicable):

WIOA Youth Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration as part of an award totaling \$1,007,590 for Clark, Cowlitz and Wahkiakum Counties. The proportion of which amounts to \$837,580 for WIOA Youth Clark County, and \$170,010 for WIOA Youth Cowlitz/Wahkiakum Counties.

Fourth Plain Navigator Program is supported and funded by non-federal grants distributed by Key Bank Foundation and the City of Vancouver totalling \$30,000. The proportions of which amount to \$20,000 granted by Key Bank Foundation, and \$10,000 granted by the City of Vancouver.

SummerWorks Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration as part of an award totaling \$300,000 with \$200,000 being allocated to WIOA funding and \$100,000 being non-federal funds.
