Program Funding

In compliance with the Stevens Amendment, funding details for program year 2021-2022 are provided as follows (Note: this includes carry forward funding from prior program years, as applicable):

WIOA Youth Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor as part of an award totaling \$896,094.61 with \$19,627.42 DVR (0%) and \$72,034.19 (0%) of non-federal funds.

Education and Employment Training Program (EET) Grant is supported by the Clark County Juvenile Court as part of an award totaling \$43,400 with all funds coming from state funds.
