

Program Funding

In compliance with the Stevens Amendment, funding details for program year 2023-2024 are provided as follows (Note: this includes carry forward funding from prior program years, as applicable):

Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act grant

The WIOA Title 1 Youth program is financed by a \$1,251,388.06 (99.7%) Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act grant from the U.S. Department of Labor and \$3,250 (.3%) non-federal funds, for a total of \$1,254,638.06 provided through Workforce Southwest Washington.

Community Project Funding grant – SummerWorks

Next is an initiative of Workforce Southwest Washington. SummerWorks is fully financed by a \$499,348.56 (100%) Community Project Funding grant from the U.S. Department of Labor provided through Workforce Southwest Washington.

City of Vancouver – Community Development Block grant

The Child Care Partnership project is fully funded by a Community and Development Block Grant (CDBG) totaling \$40,000 (100%) from the City of Vancouver HUD funds provided through Workforce Southwest Washington.
